Sweet Temptations Quilt - Fabric List

This fabric list is for the quilt layout shown on the next page. You can make many different quilts with this set. Several other layouts will be included in the final quilt assembly instructions in December.

All yardages listed refer to 44" wide fabric. All fabric should be pre-shrunk, ironed, and starched for best results. If the fabric you choose will shrink, please buy extra. If you plan to make coordinating projects, please buy extra fabric. Appliqué fabric has not been included. (I used coordinating fat quarters for the appliqués.)



MAIN QUILT SQUARES

There are several ways to piece your quilt squares. If you piece all 13 main squares as shown in the picture at the right (all matching center patches, all matching border patches), you will need the fabric amounts listed below. If you are using a striped or patterned fabric for any of the patches and need to fussy cut, please buy extra fabric.

For a quilt made from the 4x4 Squares

Center patches: $\frac{1}{4}$ yd
Border patches: $\frac{1}{4}$ yd

For a quilt made from the 5x5 Squares

Center patches: $\frac{1}{4}$ yd
Border patches: $\frac{3}{8}$ yd

For a quilt made from the 6x6 Squares

Center patches: $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
Border patches: $\frac{3}{8}$ yd

SCALLOPED HALF SQUARES AND CORNER SQUARES

If you make all of the scalloped blocks with the same two fabrics, you will need the yardages listed below.



For a quilt made from the 4x4 Squares

Fabric 1: $\frac{3}{8}$ yd
Fabric 2: $\frac{3}{8}$ yd

For a quilt made from the 5x5 Squares

Fabric 1: $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
Fabric 2: $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

For a quilt made from the 6x6 Squares

Fabric 1: $\frac{3}{4}$ yd
Fabric 2: $\frac{3}{4}$ yd

HALF SQUARES AND CORNER SQUARES

If you make all of the half squares and corner squares with the same fabric, you will need the yardages listed below:

Half Square

Corner Square

For a quilt made from the 4x4 Squares

Fabric 1: $\frac{3}{8}$ yd

For a quilt made from the 5x5 Squares

Fabric 1: $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

For a quilt made from the 6x6 Squares

Fabric 1: $\frac{5}{8}$ yd

SASHING

Fabric for the sashing for a quilt made from:

- 4x4 Squares: $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
- 5x5 Squares: $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
- 6x6 Squares: $\frac{3}{4}$ yd

QUILT BACK

Fabric for the back of a quilt made from:

- 4x4 Squares: 1 yd
- 5x5 Squares: $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd
- 6x6 Squares: $2\frac{2}{3}$ yd (You will have a seam in the back of this quilt. If you can find extra wide quilt back fabric, you will only need $1\frac{1}{3}$ yd.)

BINDING

Fabric for the binding of a quilt made from:

- 4x4 Squares: $\frac{1}{4}$ yd
- 5x5 Squares: $\frac{1}{4}$ yd
- 6x6 Squares: $\frac{1}{4}$ yd

FINISHED QUILT SIZES

For a quilt in the layout shown below made from:

- 4x4 Squares: About 32" x 32"
- 5x5 Squares: About 40" x 40"
- 6x6 Squares: About 46" x 46"
